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ABOUT GRANGE COURT

Grange Court is an elegant residence set in south-facing gardens. Situated just below Baildon Moor and the village itself, the home is on a main bus route and close to a train station, with easy access to local amenities including shops, a post office and a well-equipped community centre.

The historic house is made from traditional Yorkshire stone and benefits from large windows and spacious rooms which have many original features. Residents enjoy spending time outside in the carefully-designed gardens with sunny patio.



OUR VALUES

Our care approach is both personalised and collaborative, recognising that meeting residents' needs and wishes is essential and that this is a partnership based on strong and positive relationships.

Our 'Residents' Charter of Rights' is observed by all care staff and is laid out below.



GRANGE COURT RESIDENTS' CHARTER OF RIGHTS

Residents shall have the right:

- To retain their personal dignity and independence irrespective of the severity of their physical or mental infirmity.
- To have their social, emotional, religious, cultural and political needs accepted and respected.
- To have skilled, sensitive and understanding care to enable them to achieve the highest possible quality of life.
- To have their personal privacy respected.
- To be consulted about daily living arrangements in Grange Court and to participate in discussions about proposed changes to these arrangements.
- To be involved and be kept informed about their individual assessment of need.
- To have a regular review of their individual circumstances and to have the right to be present at any review meetings.
- To make informed choices about their care plans.
- To be kept informed of all the services offered by Grange Court.
- To choose their own medical practitioner and to consult them in private.
- To manage their own personal affairs, including finances (if mental capacity allows).
- Not to be moved without prior consultation.
- To have access to a formal complaints procedure.
- To be given the opportunity to vote in local and general elections.



ACTIVITIES

The atmosphere at Grange Court is friendly and relaxed and socialising is an important part of daily life. We run a varied calendar of events which includes games, quizzes, crafts, sing-songs, chair aerobics, garden parties and barbecues. We encourage our residents to join in with activities like embroidery, painting, bingo and board games. We have regular visits from professional entertainers from musicians to magicians. Special occasions, whether birthdays or national events, are celebrated. Our care team also arrange outings to the local area and further afield.

MEALTIMES

Residents choose from a varied and plentiful menu of home-cooked meals using seasonal, fresh produce. As well as breakfast, lunch and dinner, refreshments and snacks (including delicious homemade cakes and biscuits) are available throughout the day. Our dining rooms are elegant and spacious and mealtimes offer a great opportunity for socialising. One of our dining rooms has a bar offering a selection of wines and beers.



ACCOMMODATION

Grange Court provides 24 hour residential care for 30 ladies and gentleman for both long and short stays.

We have a number of communal rooms, including three lounges, two dining rooms and a bright and airy conservatory. These rooms are for relaxing and for social activities.

Our bedrooms are single, and most are en-suite. These rooms are the private space of the person living in that room. Residents are encouraged to bring their own belongings and furnishings to personalise their room. Every room has a nurse call system and private phone lines are available by arrangement. We do all we can to create a 'home from home' and help people live as independently as possible in comfortable surroundings.





RESIDENTIAL CARE

Grange Court offers accommodation, personal care, support, and meals to people when it has become too much for them to manage at home. Short-breaks, respite periods and longer-term options are all available at Grange Court, which enjoys a quiet spot in a sought-after residential area in Baildon.

RESPITE CARE

Caring for a dependent is often very rewarding, but it can also be challenging, which is why we offer short-breaks and respite care for adults of all ages at Grange Court. A change of scenery and a break of routine can be very beneficial to everyone concerned.



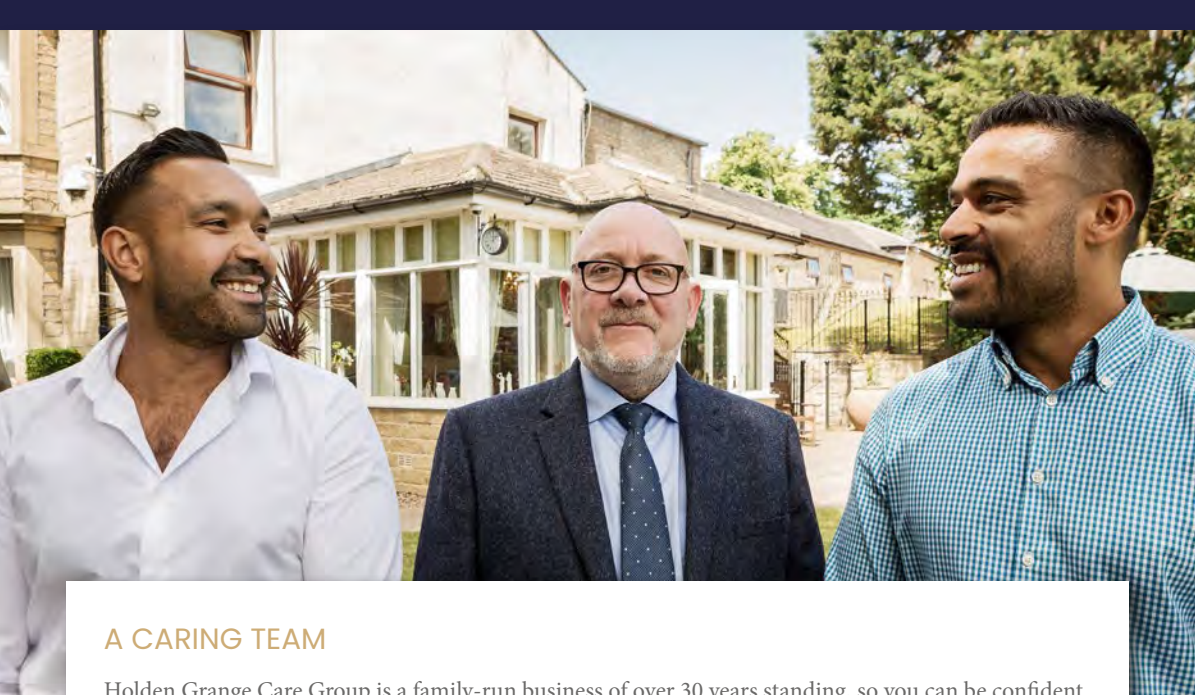
PALLIATIVE CARE
